

St James' Anglican Church
Cnr Russell and Mort Streets



Dedicated in December 1869, St James' is the oldest church in Toowoomba. Designed by architect R.G. Suter, it was built on land given by Hon. James Taylor. Memorials, stained glass windows, and the chancel screen are some of the many gifts given by noted citizens of the era. The pipe organ (1882) is a fine example of a 19th century instrument.

St Patrick's Cathedral
Cnr James and Neil Streets



This fine stone building was dedicated on St Patrick's day 1889. It replaced two former wooden buildings built for the pioneering Catholic community, the first built in 1863 but destroyed by fire in 1880. The church became a Cathedral in 1929 and significant extensions were added in 1934 to include a new sanctuary, pipe organ and memorial windows.

St Matthew's Anglican Church
Beatrice Street, Drayton



The Stone Church of St Matthew was dedicated in 1887, replacing the simple wooden structure used as a church by the Reverend Benjamin Glennie from 1859. Additions to the church included a sanctuary added in 1933, a stone vestry and the bell tower, moved to a free standing structure. Many memorials to pioneer families enhance the interior.

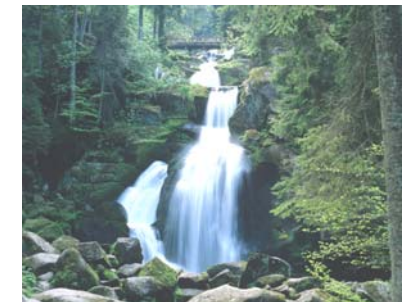

The Anglican Church of St Luke
Cnr Ruthven & Herries Streets



The church of St Luke was dedicated in 1897. Built of local bluestone and freestone it is of 13th century Gothic design. A much valued Norman and Beard pipe organ (1907), stained glass windows, and many memorials grace the interior. Adjacent is the Hall, built in 1911 from a distinctive Harry Mark's architectural design and, like the church and pipe organ, is National Trust listed.
